The Social Security (Inherited SERPS) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2001

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Inherited SERPS) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2001 and shall come into operation on 6th October 2002.
 - (2) In these Regulations—
 - "additional pension" means an additional pension derived from contributions or earnings factors in any tax year beginning after 5th April 1978 and ending before 6th April 2002;
 - "pensionable age" has the meaning given by the rules in Part I of Schedule 2 to the Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1995(1);
 - "widowed parent's allowance" means an allowance referred to in section 39A(2) of the Contributions and Benefits Act.
