GENERAL APPEAL MATTERS

Making an application for a direction

7. An application for a direction to be made by an appeal tribunal shall—
 - (a) be made in writing to the Board;
 - (b) contain sufficient information for the Board to determine the identity of the applicant; and
 - (c) be signed by or on behalf of the appellant.
