**Road Vehicles Lighting (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 2003**

*Made* - - - - - *13th January 2003*

*Coming into operation* *25th February 2003*

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 55(1) and (2) and 110(2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1995<sup>(a)</sup> and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Regulations shall be cited as the Road Vehicles Lighting (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003 and shall come into operation on 25th February 2003.

**Amendment to Schedule 19**

**2.** In Part III of Schedule 19 to the Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2000<sup>(b)</sup> for diagrams 1 to 5 there shall be substituted the diagrams set out in the Schedule.
