Dundrod Circuit (Admission Charges) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003

Made - - - - 9th December 2003

Coming into operation 1st May 2004

The Department for Regional Development(\mathbf{a}), in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 3(7A)(b) of the Road Races (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(\mathbf{b}) and now exercisable by it(\mathbf{c}), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dundrod Circuit (Admission Charges) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003 and shall come into operation on 1st May 2004.

Charges

2. The maximum charge for a spectator badge in respect of each person shall be £15.00.

Revocation

3. The Dundrod Circuit (Admission Charges) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2002(**d**) are hereby revoked.
