# Registration of Establishments (Laying Hens) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003

### Prohibition on operation or bringing into service of establishments

- **5.**—(1) A person shall not continue to operate an establishment after 1st March 2004 unless an application has been made to the Department to note that establishment on the register.
- (2) A person shall not bring an establishment into operation after 1st March 2004 unless an application has been made to note that establishment on the register and a distinguishing number communicated to the applicant by the Department.
- (3) Applications shall contain the information set out in the Schedule and shall be in such form as the Department may require.
- (4) The operator of an establishment shall notify the Department of any change to the information on the register within 28 days.
