MISCELLANEOUS

Notice of termination of accommodation

- **33.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the registered person shall not terminate the arrangements for the accommodation of a patient unless he has given reasonable notice of his intention to do so to
 - (a) the patient;
 - (b) the person who appears to be the patient's next of kin; and
 - (c) where an HSS Trust has made arrangements for the provision of accommodation, and nursing to the patient at the home, that Trust.
 - (2) If it is impracticable for the registered person to comply with the requirement in paragraph (1)
 - (a) he shall do so as soon as it is practicable to do so; and
 - (b) he shall provide to the Regulation and Improvement Authority a statement as to the circumstances which made it impracticable for him to comply with the requirement.
