MISCELLANEOUS

**Appointment of liquidators etc.**

- 34.**—(1) Any person to whom paragraph (2) applies must –
- (a) forthwith notify the Regulation and Improvement Authority of his appointment, indicating the reasons for it;
  - (b) appoint a manager to take full-time day-to-day charge of the residential care home in any case where there is no registered manager; and
  - (c) within 28 days of his appointment notify the Regulation and Improvement Authority of his intentions regarding the future operation of the home.
- (2) This paragraph applies to any person appointed as –
- (a) the receiver or manager of the property of a company or partnership which is a registered provider in respect of a home;
  - (b) a liquidator or provisional liquidator of a company which is a registered provider of a home; or
  - (c) the trustee in bankruptcy of a registered provider of a home.
