

## SCHEDULE 2

### INFORMATION REQUIRED IN RESPECT OF PERSONS SEEKING TO CARRY ON, MANAGE OR WORK AT AN ESTABLISHMENT OR AGENCY

8. Details of any criminal offences –
  - (a) of which the person has been convicted, including details of any convictions which are spent within the meaning of Article 3 of the Rehabilitation of Offenders (Northern Ireland) Order 1978<sup>(1)</sup> and which may be disclosed by virtue of the Rehabilitation of Offenders (Exceptions) Order (Northern Ireland 1979)<sup>(2)</sup>; or
  - (b) in respect of which he has been cautioned by a constable and which, at the time the caution was given, he admitted.
