# PART 4

### ENFORCEMENT

#### **Obstruction of British sea-fishery officers**

**29.**—(1) Any person who –

- (a) fails without reasonable excuse to comply with any requirement imposed by a British seafishery officer under the powers conferred on British sea-fishery officers by Articles 25 and 26;
- (b) without reasonable excuse prevents, or attempts to prevent, any other person from complying with any such requirement; or
- (c) assaults a person who is exercising any of the powers conferred on him by Articles 25 to 27 or intentionally obstructs him in the exercise of any of those powers,

is guilty of an offence.

- (2) A person guilty of an offence under paragraph (1) is liable
  - (a) on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum; or
  - (b) on conviction on indictment to a fine.
