**The Civil Partnership Act 2004 (Relationships Arising  
Through Civil Partnership) Order (Northern Ireland) 2005**

**Amendment of Schedule 22 to the Act**

**2.** In Schedule 22 to the Act (references to stepchildren etc. in existing Northern Ireland legislation), after paragraph 24 insert—

“25 Section 4(3) of the Workmen’s Compensation Act (Northern Ireland) 1927 (Meaning of “workman”).(1).

26 Article 5(3) of the Pneumoconiosis, etc., (Workers' Compensation) (Northern Ireland) Order 1979 (Meaning of “dependant”)(2).”
