**Superannuation (Chief Electoral Officer for Northern Ireland)  
Order (Northern Ireland) 2006**

*Made* - - - - - *5th April 2006*

*Coming into operation* *28th April 2006*

The Department of Finance and Personnel makes the following Order, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 3(4) and (7) of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972<sup>(a)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(b)</sup>.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Superannuation (Chief Electoral Officer for Northern Ireland) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006 and shall come into operation on 28th April 2006.

**Addition to list of employments and offices**

2. There shall be added to the employments listed in Schedule 1 to the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 with effect from 1st April 2006 employment in the office of the Chief Electoral Officer for Northern Ireland.

3. There shall be added to the offices listed in Schedule 1 to the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 with effect from 1st April 2006 the office of the Chief Electoral Officer for Northern Ireland.
