# The Employment Equality (Age) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006

## PART 2

## DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING

#### Assisting persons to obtain employment etc.

- **23.**—(1) It is unlawful for the Department for Employment and Learning to discriminate against any person by subjecting him to a detriment, or to subject a person to harassment, in the provision of facilities or services under section 1 of the Employment and Training (Northern Ireland) Act 1950(1) (general functions of the Department as to employment and training for employment).
  - (2) This regulation does not apply in a case where—
    - (a) regulation 21 (the provision of vocational training) applies, or would apply but for the operation of any other provision of these Regulations, or
    - (b) the Department for Employment and Learning is acting as an employment agency within the meaning of regulation 22 (employment agencies, careers guidance etc.).
