**The Salaries (Assembly Ombudsman and Commissioner for
Complaints) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006**

Made - - - - *2nd November 2006*

Coming into operation - *7th December 2006*

The Office of the First Minister and deputy First Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 5(1) and (2) of the Ombudsman (Northern Ireland) Order 1996(a) and Article 4(1) and (2) of the Commissioner for Complaints (Northern Ireland) Order 1996(b) and now vested in it(c) makes the following Order:

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Salaries (Assembly Ombudsman and Commissioner for Complaints) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006 and shall come into operation on 7th December 2006.

Revocation

2. The Salaries (Assembly Ombudsman and Commissioner for Complaints) (No.2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2005(d) is revoked.

Increase in Salaries

3. The annual salaries payable to the Assembly Ombudsman and the Commissioner for Complaints shall be increased from £116,515 to £117,680 from 1st April 2006 and then increased to £120,300 from 1st November 2006.

This Order provides for an increase in the annual salaries payable to the Assembly Ombudsman for Northern Ireland and the Northern Ireland Commissioner for Complaints.

This provision is made with retrospective effect from 1st April 2006 under Article 5(2) of the Ombudsman (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 and Article 4(2) of the Commissioner for Complaints (Northern Ireland) Order 1996.
