PART III

CONDUCT OF DOMICILIARY CARE AGENCIES

CHAPTER I

QUALITY OF SERVICE PROVISION

Provision of information to service users

- **18.**—(1) The registered person shall ensure that before a domiciliary care worker is supplied to a service user, the service user is informed of—
 - (a) the name of the domiciliary care worker to be supplied, and the means of contacting him;
 - (b) the name of the member of staff of the agency who is responsible for the supply of that domiciliary care worker; and
 - (c) where the agency is acting otherwise than as an employment agency, details of how he may contact the registered person, or a person nominated to act on behalf of the registered person.
- [F1(1A)] Where the agency supplies a domiciliary care worker to a service user in the circumstances mentioned in regulation 13(2), and the agency is acting as an employment agency, the registered person must—
 - (a) inform the service user of the information and documents mentioned in paragraphs 2 and 4 to 12 of Schedule 3 that are not yet available;
 - (b) inform the service user when the information and documents are available.]
- [F2(2)] The registered person must ensure, where appropriate, that the information specified in paragraph (1) and, where applicable, paragraph (1A) is provided to the service user's relatives or carers.]
