# CONDUCT OF DOMICILIARY CARE AGENCIES CHAPTER 4

### NOTICES TO BE GIVEN TO THE [<sup>F1</sup>RQIA]

#### Death of registered person

**30.**—(1) If more than one person is registered in respect of an agency, and a registered person dies, the surviving registered person shall without delay notify the  $[^{F1}RQIA]$  of the death in writing.

(2) If only one person is registered in respect of an agency, and he dies, his personal representatives must notify the [ $^{F1}$ RQIA] in writing—

- (a) without delay of the death; and
- (b) within 28 days of their intentions regarding the future running of the agency.

(3) The personal representatives of the deceased registered provider may carry on the agency without being registered in respect of it—

- (a) for a period not exceeding 28 days; and
- (b) for any further period as may be determined in accordance with paragraph (4).

(4) The [<sup>F1</sup>RQIA] may extend the period specified in paragraph (3)(a) by such further period, not exceeding one year, as the [<sup>F1</sup>RQIA] shall determine, and shall notify any such determination to the personal representatives in writing.

(5) The personal representatives shall appoint a person to manage the agency during any period in which, in accordance with paragraph (3), they carry on the agency without being registered in respect of it.
