**New paragraph (5) to regulation 2 of the Equality Act (Sexual Orientation) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 2006**

3. Insert at the end of regulation 2 a new paragraph (5) as follows—

“For the purposes of these Regulations a non-discrimination notice or a finding by the court becomes final when —

- (a) an appeal against the notice or finding is dismissed, withdrawn or abandoned; or
- (b) the time for appealing expires without an appeal having been brought;

and for the purposes of subparagraph (a) an appeal against a non-discrimination notice shall be taken to be dismissed if, notwithstanding that a requirement of the notice is quashed on appeal, a direction is given in respect of it under regulation 38.”
