PART IV

MEASURES ON CONFIRMATION OF HIGHLY PATHOGENIC AVIAN
INFLUENZA AT PREMISES OTHER THAN A REGULATED PLACE

Restrictions on trade in things from areas where measures have been disapplied

32. Unless licenced by the Department, a person shall not supply any of the following for [^{F1}export outside the United Kingdom] if it has come from premises in respect of which any of the measures in Schedules 4 or 5 have been disapplied under regulations 30 or 31—

- (a) poultry;
- (b) other captive birds;
- (c) hatching eggs;
- (d) used litter;
- (e) manure;
- (f) slurry.
