**The Smoke-free (Premises, Vehicle Operators and
Penalty Notices) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007**

Failing to prevent smoking in smoke-free vehicles

[^{F1}3.—(1) The persons set out in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this regulation are under a duty corresponding to that in Article 9(1) of the Order to cause any person who is smoking in a smoke-free vehicle to stop smoking.

(2) In respect of a vehicle that is smoke-free by virtue of regulation 12(1) of the Smoke-free (Exemptions, Vehicles, Penalties and Discounted Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007—

- (a) a driver;
- (b) any person with management responsibilities for the vehicle; and
- (c) any person on a vehicle who is responsible for order or safety on it.

(3) In respect of a vehicle that is smoke-free by virtue of regulation 12(1A) of the Smoke-free (Exemptions, Vehicles, Penalties and Discounted Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007, the driver.]
