Amendment to the Valuation Tribunal Rules (Northern Ireland) 2007

5. In rule 22 (Case stated for the Court of Appeal) for paragraph (1) substitute—

- "(1) An application under-
 - (a) Article 31A(12C) of the 1977 Order; or
 - (b) regulation 12(2) of the 2007 Regulations; or
 - (c) regulation 10(2) of the 2008 Regulations,

for a case to be stated upon a point of law for the decision of the Court of Appeal shall be made by delivering to the Secretary—

- (i) within 14 days of the receipt of the notice in writing of the decision of the Valuation Tribunal by the applicant, a notice of application stating the point of law upon which the applicant wishes to have the decision of the Court of Appeal; and
- (ii) within 14 days of delivery to the Secretary of the notice of application referred to in sub-paragraph (i), a draft case.".
