# The Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups (Barring Procedure) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2008

### The minimum barred period: persons not subject to previous restrictions

- 10.—(1) This regulation applies to any person to whom none of regulations 5 to 9 apply.
- (2) In relation to any person who has not reached the age of 18 when [FIDBS] includes him in a barred list the minimum barred period is 1 year.
- (3) In relation to any person who has reached the age of 18 but has not reached the age of 25 when [FIDBS] includes him in a barred list the minimum barred period is 5 years.
- (4) In relation to any person who has reached the age of 25 when [FIDBS] includes him in a barred list the minimum barred period is 10 years.
