**The Drinking Milk Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2008**

**Application of provisions of the 1991 Order**

7. The following provisions of the 1991 Order shall apply for the purposes of these Regulations with the modification that any reference in those provisions to the 1991 Order or Part thereof shall be construed as a reference to these Regulations—

- (a) Article 2(4) (which relates to extended meaning of “sale”);
- (b) Article 3 (application to food offered as prizes etc.);
- (c) Article 4 (presumptions that food intended for human consumption);
- (d) Article 19 (offences due to fault of another person);
- (e) Article 20 (defence of due diligence) as it applies for the purposes of Article 13 or 14;
- (f) Article 30(8) (which relates to documentary evidence);
- (g) Article 34 (obstruction etc., of officers); and
- (h) Article 36 (punishment of offences) in so far as it relates to offences under Article 34(1) and (2).
