## The Taxis (Enniskillen) (Revocation) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 2008

Made	-	18th June 2008
Coming into operation	-	25th July 2008

The Department of the Environment makes the following Bye-Laws in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 65(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(**a**).

#### Citation and commencement

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Taxis (Enniskillen) (Revocation) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 2008 and shall come into operation on  $25^{\text{th}}$  July 2008.

#### Revocation

2. The Taxis (Enniskillen) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 2006(b) are hereby revoked.
