**The Social Security (Claims and Payments)
(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2009**

Amendment of the Jobseeker's Allowance Regulations

3. In regulation 1(2) (interpretation) of the Jobseeker's Allowance Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996⁽¹⁾ for the definition of "benefit week" substitute—

““benefit week” means—

- (a) a period of 7 days ending with a day determined in accordance with paragraph (b) unless, in any particular case or class of case, the Department arranges otherwise;
- (b) the day specified for the purposes of paragraph (a) is the day in column (2) which corresponds to the series of numbers in column (1) which includes the last 2 digits of the person's national insurance number—

<i>Column (1)</i>	<i>Column (2)</i>
00 to 19	Monday
20 to 39	Tuesday
40 to 59	Wednesday
60 to 79	Thursday
80 to 99	Friday”.
