The Waste Batteries and Accumulators (Treatment and Disposal) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2009

Amendment of the Pollution Prevention and Control Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003

7. After regulation 12A(1) (Conditions of permits: solvents) of the Pollution Prevention and Control Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003(2) there shall be inserted—

“Conditions of permits: waste batteries and accumulators

12B. A permit which on or after 1st January 2010 authorises the operation of a waste incineration installation shall contain such conditions as the enforcing authority considers necessary to give effect to Article 14 of Directive [2006/66/EC](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council on batteries and accumulators and waste batteries and accumulators and repealing Directive [91/157/EEC](#)(3).”.
