**The Motor Hackney Carriages (Belfast) (Amendment  
No. 2) By-Laws (Northern Ireland) 2009**

*Made* - - - - - *23rd July 2009*  
*Coming into operation* *17th August 2009*

The Department of the Environment makes the following By-Laws in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 65(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(1).

**Citation and commencement**

1. These By-Laws may be cited as the Motor Hackney Carriages (Belfast) (Amendment No. 2) By-Laws (Northern Ireland) 2009 and shall come into operation on 17<sup>th</sup> August 2009.

**By-Laws amended**

2. In the Schedule to the By-Laws made in respect of Motor Hackney Carriages standing or plying for hire made by the Council of the County Borough of Belfast on 4<sup>th</sup> June 1951(2), after the entry for Brunswick Street insert—

---

“CHICHESTER STREET	North Side: from a point 38 metres west of the west kerbline of Victoria Street for a distance of 53 metres in a westerly direction. Carriages shall stand in a single line by the kerbline and parallel therewith facing east.	10	At any time”.
