**The Rathgael Road, Bangor (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2009**

*Made* - - - - - *29th September 2009*

*Coming into operation* - *18th November 2009*

The Department for Regional Development<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order is of the opinion that the area of road described in the Schedule is not necessary for road traffic.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

One objection was received and duly considered.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The Rathgael Road, Bangor (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2009 and shall come into operation on 18th November 2009.

**Application**

2. The area of road described in the Schedule is abandoned.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned area of road shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.
