
STATUTORY RULES OF NORTHERN IRELAND

2009 No. 418

The Income Support (Prescribed Categories of Person) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2009

Revocation and Savings

2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the following provisions of the Income Support (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(1) are revoked—

- (a) regulation 13(2)(b) and (bb)(2) (circumstances in which persons in relevant education are to be entitled to income support);
- (b) paragraphs 7(a) and (b) (persons incapable of work), 10(3) (disabled students), 12(4) (deaf students) and 13 (blind persons) of Schedule 1B(5) (prescribed categories of person).

(2) A provision referred to in paragraph (1) (“a relevant provision”) continues to have effect in relation to a person (“P”)—

- (a) who immediately before the appointed day, is entitled to an award of income support on the basis of a relevant provision, or
- (b) whose claim for income support falls within regulation 2(2)(b)(6), (c) or (d)(7) (claim for an existing benefit) of the Employment and Support Allowance (Transitional Provisions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2008(8), or
- (c) to whom paragraph (4) applies.

(3) For the purposes of paragraph (2)(a), P is entitled to an award of income support on the basis of a relevant provision only where—

- (a) before the appointed day the Department determined that a relevant provision applies to P, or
- (b) in the cases to which regulation 6(9) (information required for determining capacity for work) or 28(10) (conditions for treating a person as incapable of work until the personal capability assessment is carried out) of the Social Security (Incapacity for Work) (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995(11) applies, before the appointed day the Department was—

- (i) provided with the evidence or satisfied on the basis of the information required by regulation 6 of those Regulations, or
- (ii) provided with the evidence required by regulation 28(2)(a) of those Regulations and the condition in regulation 28(2)(b) was satisfied, or
- (c) in any case to which the regulations referred to in sub-paragraph (b) do not apply, the Department—
 - (i) before the appointed day received notification from P stating that a relevant provision applies to P, and
 - (ii) determines on or after that date that the provision concerned applies to P.
- (4) This paragraph applies to a person where—
 - (a) that person had an award of income support which was terminated on or after 27th October 2008;
 - (b) a relevant provision applied to the person immediately before the award was terminated;
 - (c) the decision to terminate that award was made as a result of official error, and
 - (d) that decision is subsequently revised by reason of that error.
- (5) In paragraph (4)(c) “official error” has the meaning given in regulation 1(2) (citation, commencement and interpretation) of the Social Security and Child Support (Decisions and Appeals) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1999⁽¹²⁾.
