**The Social Security (National Insurance Number Information: Exemption) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2009**

**Amendment of the Housing Benefit (Persons who have attained the qualifying age for state pension credit) Regulations**

**10.** In regulation 4 of the Housing Benefit (Persons who have attained the qualifying age for state pension credit) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006<sup>(1)</sup> (cases in which section 1(1A) of the Administration Act is disapplied)—

- (a) at the end of paragraph (a) omit “or”;
- (b) at the end of paragraph (b) add “; or” and the following paragraph—
  - “(c) to a person who—
    - (i) is a person in respect of whom a claim for housing benefit is made;
    - (ii) is subject to immigration control within the meaning of section 115(9)(a) of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999;
    - (iii) is a person from abroad for the purposes of these Regulations as defined in regulation 10(2), and
    - (iv) has not previously been allocated a national insurance number.”.
