Amendment of the Income Support (General) Regulations

- **5.** In regulation 2A of the Income Support (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(1) (disapplication of section 1(1A) of the Administration Act), at the end of paragraph (b) add—
 - "(c) to a person who—
 - (i) is a person in respect of whom a claim for income support is made,
 - (ii) is subject to immigration control within the meaning of section 115(9)(a) of the Immigration and Asylum Act,
 - (iii) is not entitled to income support for the purposes of section 123 of the Contributions and Benefits Act(2), and
 - (iv) has not previously been allocated a national insurance number.".
