PART 5

VALIDITY OF LICENCES AND CERTIFICATES

Periodic checks to maintain validity of licence

13.—(1) The holder of a train driving licence [^{F1}a GB train driving licence or a European train driving licence] must pass periodic medical and psychological examinations relating to the requirements described in regulation 8(3) and (4).

(2) For the purpose of paragraph (1) periodic examinations with regard to medical requirements means examinations conducted at the minimum frequency and at other times set out in paragraph 3 of Schedule 1.
