# The Motor Vehicles (Driving Instruction) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010

### PART 5

#### **SUPPLEMENTARY**

#### **Exemption of police instructors**

- **20.**—(1) Article 48 of the Order of 2007 shall not apply to the giving of instruction by a police instructor in pursuance of arrangements made by the Chief Constable.
  - (2) In this regulation—
    - "police instructor" means—
    - (a) an officer of the Police Service of Northern Ireland(1) whose duties consist of or include, or have consisted of or included, the giving of instruction in the driving of motor cars [F1] or the riding of motorcycles to officers of the Police Service of Northern Ireland; or
    - (b) any person employed by the Northern Ireland Policing Board for the purpose of giving such instruction to members of the Police Service of Northern Ireland.
