**The Motor Vehicles (Driving Instruction)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010**

PART 5

SUPPLEMENTARY

Exemption of police instructors

20.—(1) Article 48 of the Order of 2007 shall not apply to the giving of instruction by a police instructor in pursuance of arrangements made by the Chief Constable.

(2) In this regulation—

“police instructor” means—

- (a) an officer of the Police Service of Northern Ireland⁽¹⁾ whose duties consist of or include, or have consisted of or included, the giving of instruction in the driving of motor cars [^{F1}or the riding of motorcycles] to officers of the Police Service of Northern Ireland; or
- (b) any person employed by the Northern Ireland Policing Board for the purpose of giving such instruction to members of the Police Service of Northern Ireland.
