**Superannuation (Office of the Director and Deputy Director of
Public Prosecutions) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011**

Made - - - - - *18th March 2011*

Coming into operation - *11th April 2011*

The Department of Finance and Personnel makes the following Order, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 3(4) and (7) of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 (a) and now vested in it (b).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Superannuation (Office of the Director and Deputy Director of Public Prosecutions) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011 and shall come into operation on 11th April 2011.

Additions to list of offices

2. There shall be added to the offices listed in Schedule 1 to the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 with effect from 12th April 2010, the offices of,

- (a) the Director of Public Prosecutions for Northern Ireland;
- (b) the Deputy Director of Public Prosecutions for Northern Ireland (c); and
- (c) any person appointed to act as Deputy Director of Public Prosecutions for Northern Ireland.
