**The Environmental Liability (Prevention and Remediation)
(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2011**

Made - - - - 3rd June 2011

Coming into operation 25th June 2011

The Department of the Environment, being a Department⁽¹⁾ designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972⁽²⁾ in relation to the environment, acting in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by that section, makes the following Regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Environmental Liability (Prevention and Remediation) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2011 and come into operation on 25th June 2011.

(2) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954⁽³⁾ applies to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Assembly.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Environmental Liability (Prevention and Remediation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2009 which implement Directive [2004/35/EC](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council on environmental liability with regard to the prevention and remedying of environmental damage (“the Environmental Liability Directive”). The Regulations make provision for implementing an amendment to the Environmental Liability Directive by Article 34 of Directive [2009/31/EC](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 April 2009 on the geological storage of carbon dioxide.
