**The Waiting Restrictions (Dungannon) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 2011**

Made - - - - - *28th September 2011*

Coming into operation - *20th October 2011*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a Notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Waiting Restrictions (Dungannon) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011 and shall come into operation on 20th October 2011.

Amendment

2. The Waiting Restrictions (Dungannon) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010^(d) shall be amended by the addition to Schedule 2 of the following item—

“4. Barrack Street (north-east side) — from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Scotch Street for a distance of 125 metres in a south-easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Waiting Restrictions (Dungannon) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 (“the 2010 Order”) by the addition of the item in Article 2 to Schedule 2. The effect of the amendment is to prohibit vehicles waiting between the hours 8.30 a.m. and 6.15 p.m. on the days Monday to Saturday inclusive on the length of road specified.

A penalty charge (£60) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the 2010 Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
