IMPORTATION FROM A THIRD COUNTRY

Consignments of products likely to constitute a risk to animal or human health

[^{F1}21. If the official controls at the border control post indicate that the consignment is likely to constitute a danger to animal or human health, the official veterinary surgeon or the authorised officer (as the case may be) must immediately place the consignment under official detention and order that the person responsible for the consignment destroy it or arrange special treatment in accordance with Article 71 of the EU Regulation at that person's expense.]
