IDENTIFICATION

**Additional requirements for export**

**11.** A keeper shall not move a pig off a holding for the purposes of [<sup>F1</sup>trade with the EU] or export unless it has been identified with an eartag bearing a holding code and individual identification number, except in accordance with the conditions of a licence issued by the Department.
