PART 5 MARKETS, SLAUGHTERHOUSES & SHOWS

Slaughterhouse operator

- 16. A slaughterhouse operator shall—
 - (a) ensure that a pig is not accepted for slaughter if it is subject to a movement restriction notice served under article 19 which prevents movement to slaughter;
 - (b) take reasonable steps to be satisfied as to the traceability and provenance of any pig presented for slaughter;
 - (c) ensure that a pig is not accepted for slaughter unless it is identified in accordance with this Order, except in accordance with the conditions of a licence issued by the Department;
 - (d) ensure that a pig is not accepted for slaughter unless it is accompanied by a movement document in accordance with article 14(1);
 - (e) complete the movement document with the kill number.
