The Contaminants in Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2013

**PART 1**

Introductory

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Contaminants in Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2013 and come into operation on 31st October 2013.

**Interpretation**

2.—(1) In these Regulations —

“Regulation 124/2009” means Commission Regulation (EC) No. 124/2009 setting maximum levels for the presence of coccidiostats or histomonostats in food resulting from the unavoidable carry-over of these substances in non-target feed <sup>M2</sup>;

“the Order” means the Food Safety (Northern Ireland) Order 1991.

(2) Any other expression used in these Regulations and in <sup>F2</sup>... Regulation 1881/2006 or Regulation 124/2009 has the same meaning in these Regulations as it bears in <sup>F3</sup>... Regulation concerned.

[<sup>F4</sup>(3) Subject to regulation 2(4), any reference to an EU instrument is a reference to it as amended at the date of making these Regulations.]

(4) Any reference to an Article of or Annex to <sup>F5</sup>... Regulation 1881/2006 or Regulation 124/2009 is a reference to that Article or Annex as it may be amended from time to time.

(5) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 <sup>M3</sup> shall apply to these regulations as it applies to an Act of the Assembly.
