The Social Security (Habitual Residence) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2014

> 8th May 2014 Made Coming into operation 31st May 2014

The Department for Social Development makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 122(1)(a) and (d), 131(1) and (2) and 171(1), (3) and (4) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992(1), Articles 6(5) and (12) and 36(2) of the Jobseekers (Northern Ireland) Order 1995(2) and sections 115(3), (4) and (8) of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999(3), and now vested in it(4), sections 1(5)(a) and 19(1), (2)(a) and (3) of the State Pension Credit Act (Northern Ireland) 2002(5) and sections 4(3) and 25(2) of the Welfare Reform Act (Northern Ireland) 2007(6).

Regulations 5 and 6 are made with the consent of the Department of Finance and Personnel (7).

The Social Security Advisory Committee has agreed that proposals in respect of regulations 5 and 6 should not be referred to it(8).
