The Police and Criminal Evidence (1989 Order) (Codes of Practice) (Revision of Codes C and H) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014

Made - - - - 8th May 2014

Coming into operation - 2nd June 2014

The Department of Justice has, in pursuance of Articles 65 and 66(6) of the Police and Criminal Evidence (Northern Ireland) order 1989(a), prepared and published draft codes of practice in connection with:

- (a) the detention, treatment and questioning of persons by police officers (Code C); and
- (b) the detention, treatment and questioning of persons by police officers under section 41 of, and Schedule 8 to, the Terrorism Act 2000 (Code H);

and has considered representations made in accordance with Article 66(1) of that Order.

In pursuance of Article 66(3) of that Order the Department of Justice has laid a draft of each code of practice before the Assembly.

The Department of Justice, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 66(4) of that order, makes the following order—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. This Order may be cited as the Police and Criminal Evidence (1989 Order) (Codes of Practice) (Revision of Codes C and H) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014, and shall come into operation on 2nd June 2014.

Revision of Codes of Practice

2. The revised codes of practice C and H laid before the Assembly on 12th May 2014 shall come into operation on 2nd June 2014.
