SCHEDULE 2

RULES FOR BID BALLOTS, RENEWAL BALLOTS AND ALTERATION BALLOTS

PROVISIONS AS TO TIME

Ballots - general

4.—(1) Each ballot shall be a postal ballot.

(2) Each person entitled to vote in a BID ballot, renewal ballot, alteration ballot or re ballot, as the case may be, shall have one vote in respect of each relevant property occupied or (if unoccupied) owned by that person in the geographical area of the BID.

(3) The rateable value of relevant property for the purposes of a BID ballot, renewal ballot, alteration ballot or re ballot, as the case may be, shall be the rateable value on the NAV list as at 5 p.m. on the day of the ballot and no account shall be taken of any alteration to the rateable value which is not shown on the NAV list immediately prior to the end of the ballot.
