Salmon Drift Net Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2014

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations—

“drift net” means a net consisting of a single sheet or wall of netting loosely hung on cork and sole ropes;

“drift net licence” means a fishing licence authorising the use of drift nets for the taking of salmon in the sea.
