The Level Crossing (Cullybackey South) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015

The Department for Regional Development, (DRD) has made a Statutory Rule entitled The Level Crossing (Cullybackey South) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015 (S.R. No.13), which comes into operation on 16th February 2015.

The Order is made under the powers conferred by section 66(1) and (2) of the Transport Act (Northern Ireland) 1967.

Purpose of the Statutory Rule

This Order provides for a level crossing at Cullybackey South, which is situated in the Townland of Cullybackey in the Borough of Ballymena in County Antrim and takes account of the requirements for an automated crossing and its operational requirements. The Order takes account of a new footway over the southern side of the crossing to complete a Roads Service Scheme which will provide a footway between Cullybackey and Ballymena.

Section 47 of the Railways Clauses Consolidation Act 1845 (which requires the railway undertaking to provide gates and gate-keepers, section 6 of the Railways Clauses Act 1863 (requirements as to lodges etc) and any other statutory provision imposing requirements to the same or similar effect, shall not apply to the crossing whilst this Order remains in force.
