**The Parking Places on Roads and Waiting Restrictions (Newry)
(Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015**

Made - - - - - *21st December 2015*

Coming into operation - - - - - *18th January 2016*

The Department for Regional Development(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objections or other representations have been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places on Roads and Waiting Restrictions (Newry) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015 and shall come into operation on 18th January 2016.

Amendment

2.—(1) The Parking Places on Roads and Waiting Restrictions (Newry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015(d) is amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) In item 1 of Part 2 of Schedule 2, for the words “110 metres” substitute the words “183 metres”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places on Roads and Waiting Restrictions (Newry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015 (“the Order”) by the amendment of item 1 in Part 2 of Schedule 2 as specified in Article 2(2).

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
