PART 2

Recoverability

Recoverable amounts

- 3.—(1) In these Regulations "recoverable amount" means—
 - (a) subject to regulations 7 to 9, the amount of any overpayment; and
 - (b) any other amount recoverable under any provision of the Administration Act specified in paragraph (2).
- (2) Those provisions are—
 - (a) section 69ZE(1) (court action etc.);
 - (b) section 69ZG (recovery of payments on account);
 - (c) section 69ZH (recovery of hardship payments etc.); and
 - (d) section 109B(4)(2) (penalty as alternative to prosecution: colluding employers, etc.).
