**The Social Security (Restrictions on Amounts  
for Children and Qualifying Young Persons)  
(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2017**

*Made* - - - - *19th April 2017*  
*Laid before Parliament* *20th April 2017*  
*Coming into operation in accordance with regulation 1*

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 122(1)(a) and (d), 131(1), 132(3) and (4)(b), 133 and 171(1), (3) and (4) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992<sup>(1)</sup>, Articles 2(2), 6(5) and 14(1) and (4)(b) of the Jobseekers (Northern Ireland) Order 1995<sup>(2)</sup>, Articles 9(5)(b), 15(4), 16(3)(b) and (c), 17(1) and (4)(b), 24(2)(d), 25(1)(b), 29(7) and 48(1) and (2) of, and paragraphs 4(1)(a) and (3)(a) and 5(1) of Schedule 1 and paragraphs 1(1) and 3(1)(b) of Schedule 6 to, the Welfare Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 2015<sup>(3)</sup> and Articles 10(6) and 22 of the Welfare Reform and Work (Northern Ireland) Order 2016<sup>(4)</sup>.

Those powers are exercisable by the Secretary of State by virtue of Article 4(1)(a) and (b) of the Welfare Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 2015.
