**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**

**The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment  
No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018**

*Made* - - - - - *9th May 2018*

*Coming into operation* - *30th May 2018*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of, and paragraph 5 to Schedule 4 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedules.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018 and shall come into operation on 30th May 2018.

## Amendments

2.—(1) The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016<sup>(a)</sup> is amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) In Schedule 1—

(a) Delete the following—

- (i) item no. 315 relating to Holborn Avenue, Bangor;
- (ii) item no. 428 relating to Dunraven Park, Belfast;
- (iii) item no. 886 relating to Warren Road, Donaghadee; and
- (iv) item no. 2450 relating to John Street Lane, Newtownards.

(b) Add the items set out in Schedule 1 to this Order.

(3) In Schedule 7 add the item set out in Schedule 2 to this Order.

## SCHEDULE 1

Article 2(2)(b)

### Unlimited Waiting

- “2537. George Gardens, Ballyclare (south-west side) – from a point 98 metres south-east of its junction with George Avenue for a distance of 5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
2538. Carrickmannin Gardens, Bangor (south-east side of parking area) – from a point 70 metres west of its junction with Owenroe Drive for a distance of 2.4 metres in a westerly direction.
2539. Clara Avenue, Belfast (south-west side) – from a point 20 metres south-east of its junction with Beersbridge Road for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.
2540. Elmwood Avenue, Belfast (north-east side in a lay-by) – from a point 19.5 metres south-east of its junction with Lisburn Road for a distance of 3.6 metres in a south-easterly direction.
2541. Elmwood Avenue, Belfast (south-west side in a lay-by) – from a point 39.1 metres south-east of its junction with Lisburn Road for a distance of 3.6 metres in a south-easterly direction.
2542. Forthriver Green, Belfast (west side) – from a point 79 metres south of its junction with Forthriver Link for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction.
2543. Knocknagoney Avenue, Belfast (south side) – from a point 27 metres west of its junction with Knocknagoney Gardens for a distance of 6.6 metres in a westerly direction.
2544. Whitehall Gardens, Belfast (north-west side) – from a point 48 metres south-west of its junction with Ormeau Road for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.
2545. Meadow Bank Avenue, Donaghadee (south-east side) – from a point 22 metres south-west of its junction with William Street for a distance of 5 metres in a south-westerly direction.
2546. Pemberton Park, Downpatrick (north-west side) (in a parking area in front of No. 2) – from a point 82 metres north-east of its junction with Vianstown Park for a distance of 2.4 metres in an easterly direction.
2547. Stream Street, Downpatrick (east side) – from a point 83 metres south of its junction with St Patricks Avenue for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction.
2548. Lansdowne Crescent, Larne (south side) – from a point 58 metres east of its junction with Glenarm Road for a distance of 6 metres in an easterly direction.
2549. Mount Street, Londonderry (south-west side) – from a point 15 metres north-west of its junction with Rosemount Avenue for a distance of 6 metres in a north-westerly direction.
2550. Monkstown Gardens, Newtownabbey (north-west corner of a parking area to the side of No. 20) – from a point 200 metres north of its junction with Jordantown Road for a distance of 5 metres in a northerly direction.
2551. Rathmore Drive, Newtownabbey (north-west side in a lay-by) – from a point 40 metres south-west of its junction with Bencorm Park for a distance of 5 metres in a south-westerly direction.
2552. Mark Street, Newtownards (north side) – from a point 67 metres east of its junction with Thomas Street for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction.”

## SCHEDULE 2

Article 2(3)

Waiting limited to 3 hours on Monday to Saturday between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. with return prohibited within 1 hour or 6.00 p.m.

- “13. High Street, Portaferry (south-east side) – from a point 54 metres south-west of its junction with Ashmount Drive for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.”

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016.

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places with unlimited waiting on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 and a parking place with limited waiting specified in Schedule 2. The Order also removes the parking places referred to in Article 2(2)(a).
