**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**

**The One-Way Traffic (Newry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018**

*Made* - - - - *15th October 2018*

*Coming into operation* - *28th November 2018*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No objection or other representation has been received.

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as The One-Way Traffic (Newry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018 and shall come into operation on 28th November 2018.

**Prohibition**

**2.** A person shall not, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause or permit a vehicle to proceed along Barcroft Park, Newry from its junction with Dorans Hill at No. 1 Barcroft Park to its junction with Dorans Hill at No. 176 Barcroft Park other than in a clockwise direction.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order introduces a one-way traffic system on Barcroft Park, Newry for its entire length so that traffic can only proceed in a clockwise direction.

Any person who acts in contravention of this Order shall be guilty of an offence under the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 (“the Regulation Order”) and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£1,000) in accordance with The Road Traffic Offenders (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 as amended by the Regulation Order.
