**The Extinguishment of Right to Use Vehicles on Roads  
(Londonderry) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018**

*Made* - - - - - *16th October 2018*

*Coming into operation* - *6th November 2018*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 100(1) and (2) of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

Notice has been published and served in compliance with Article 103(1) and (2) of that Order.

No objection has been received.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The Extinguishment of Right to Use Vehicles on Roads (Londonderry) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018 and shall come into operation on 6th November 2018.

**Amendment**

2.—(1) The Extinguishment of Right to Use Vehicles on Roads (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010<sup>(d)</sup> is amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) For item 7 in Schedule 1 substitute—

“7. Police Court Street. Items 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 as set out in Schedule 2.”

(3) For item 9 in Schedule 2 substitute—

“9. where the vehicle is a taxi and provided always that the taxi shall not be permitted to use the roads or lengths of road for any longer period than may be necessary for the taking up or setting down of persons unless it is waiting on a taxi stand specified by Bye-Law No. 6 of the Bye-Laws made in respect of Motor Hackney Carriages standing or plying for hire by the County Borough of Londonderry on 28th May 1963 and confirmed by the Ministry of Home Affairs on 28th June 1963<sup>(e)</sup>.”

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

The order amends The Extinguishment of Right to Use Vehicles on Roads (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 (Article 2) to include an exception for certain taxis waiting on a stand in Police Court Street.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.
